What Does Healthy Eating Mean for My Child?

Each of the major food groups contributes specific nutrients for children's growth and development. Foods from all of the food groups are the basis of a healthy diet. Therefore, children need to eat a variety of foods from each group each day.

Milk & Milk Products - provide calcium for strong teeth and bones

Fruits & Vegetable - provide vitamins A and C to protect eyesight and for healthy skin.

Grains - provide energy for activity and growth

Meats & beans - provide protein and iron to form developing muscles

Oils - provide healthy fats for proper growth and development.

Food allergies Only about six to eight percent of children have true food allergies. It is important to have a physician diagnose a suspected food allergy. Common food allergies include eggs, fish, milk, peanuts, shellfish, soybeans, and wheat. Lactose Intolerance occurs in some children who experience stomach discomfort from digesting lactose, the sugar found in milk.
