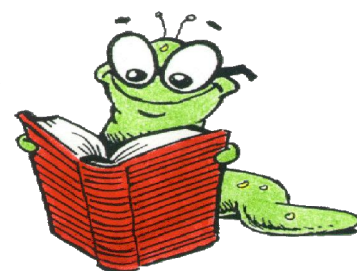
TJ Pizza Fundraiser—Orders Due October 26th
